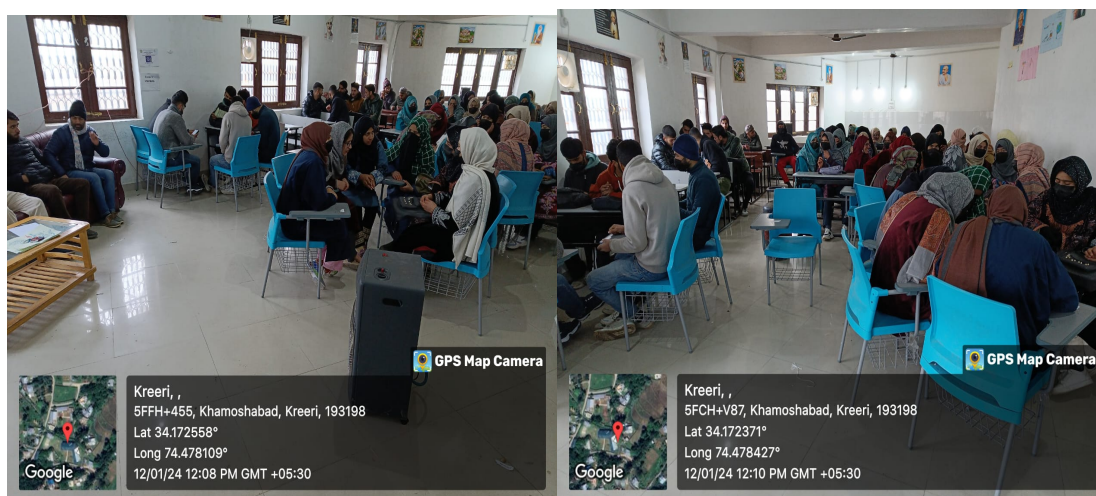
Poster Making Competition:

Awareness Rally:

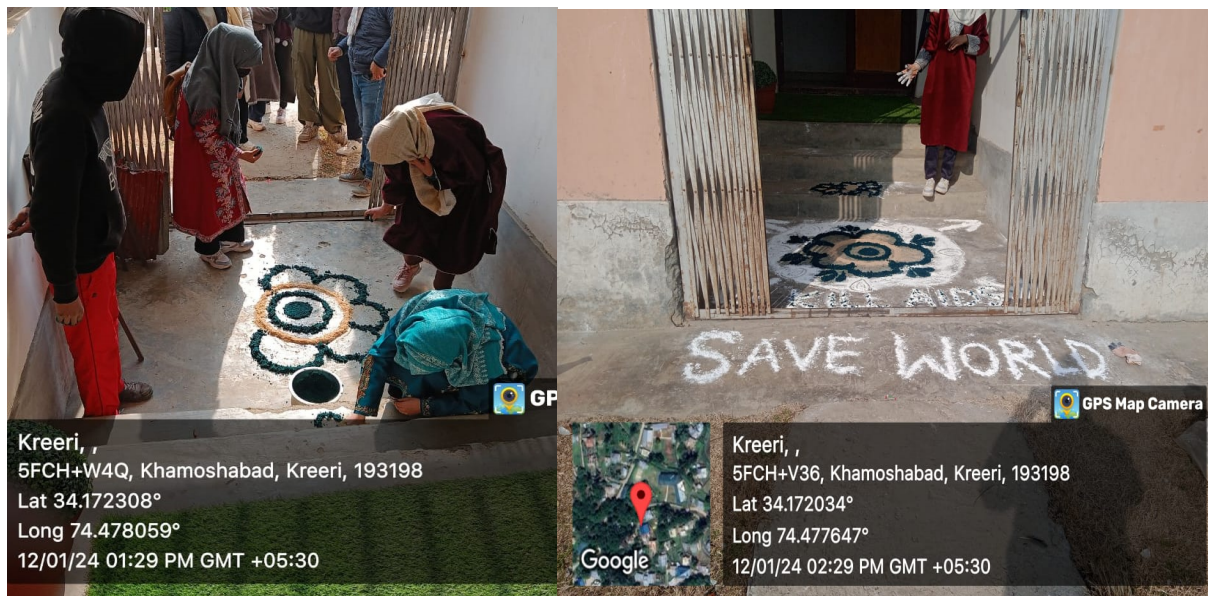
